### **Deputy Principal's Report - Elizabeth Brooks**

- Acknowledgements: Thanks extended to the community for the Rockwall rodeo and the successful workshops aiding in HSC preparations. A special thank you to Ms Alison and the introduction of 2 new staff members.
- HSC Update: English Paper 1 on Wednesday went smoothly, with no concerns.
   Discussion on ATAR, gap years, and the importance of good goal-setting habits.
- Visible Wellness Program Lea Waters: Introduction of a strength-based approach to student wellbeing, incorporating the science of positive psychology across classes, tutor groups, and extracurricular activities. Aim to embed and reimagine student skills for better wellbeing.
