Principal's Report	- Noted appointment of new principal, Mrs Johneen McPherson commencing in Jan'27 but with introductions commencing this week - initially with staff but students and parent community to follow - Noted departure of Mrs Elizabeth Brookes. Interviews commencing next week for a new deputy from a good applicant pool. - Successful school productions - Potter; A Parody (Year 11 Drama Production) & The Olympians (School Musical) - Year 12 Trials completed	



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	• Leadership has transitioned to Year 11 (Year 12 2027) • European Study Tour is taking place next school holidays • Tanzania Immersion is on track for December • “Small act, big impact” program being implemented to align with new anti-bullying legislation due in 2027 • Good progress on the Art Show and Spring Fair coming up next month • In response to the alleged incident involving Scots College boys, the College has been reinforcing messages around consent through PDHPE classes • Sisters of Charity will be ‘farewelled’ tomorrow with a Mass of Thanksgiving and Celebration - end of an era with Sr Anne Taylor concluding her ministry as College Companion meaning the College will no longer have a Sister of Charity serving • Building work continues - at post tender stage	
President's Report	• Acknowledged appointment of new principal, Mrs Johneen McPherson • The parent community looks forward to opportunities to properly farewell outgoing Principal in due course • Queries from the parent community about the College going tech free/low tech (on the basis that Sydney Grammer, where Mrs McPherson's husband is principal, is tech free/low tech). The Principal advised she hadn't heard anything to this effect and any such change would need to go through proper process including consultation. • Spring Fair - ◦ Hoping for more volunteers, will keep pushing ◦ Mufti day approved to encourage year allocated donations • Still a lot of tickets available for the Father Daughter Dinner, however not unusual for dads to buy last minute - need to sell 650 • Year 12 graduation rings to be handed out at the Graduation Ceremony on 23 September • P&F will be gifting the Sisters of Charity the “Tarmons Key” at the Mass of Thanksgiving and Celebration	



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Treasurer's Report	• P&F has a large cash balance - seeking funding proposals from the College • The Principal noted that the Principal, the Board and the Advancement Team were all in favour of a donation from the P&F to the College building works. Suggested that the P&F make a 'lead gift' to the Foundation. College to provide a list of what the P&F could make a 'lead gift' to and receive naming rights (e.g. entrance hall, gymnasium). • Other suggestions for P&F contribution - ◦ \$20,000 towards wellbeing initiatives during the period of College building works ◦ Sports staff uniforms (winter shell jacket v fleece?) • School mini bus still in production
