

Ascham 5 a-side Football COVID-19 Safety Plan

General Rules

- All Staff and Students who display any symptoms of COVID-19 are to remain at home and not attend the venue.
- Participating Schools are expected to ensure that all staff members are provided with information and training on COVID-19, including when to get tested, physical distancing and cleaning, and how to manage a sick student.
- The competition is spectator free. This includes the area around the facility. Only staff and students will be permitted entry.
- Schools are asked to encourage participants to bring their own water bottle, snacks and sweat towels.
 Please avoid shared food and drinks.
- All Staff and Students are encouraged to download the COVIDSafe app.
- Staff and Students are encouraged to avoid the use of communal facilities where possible.
- It is advised that pick up and drop off is completed via Martin Rd and Robertson road as displayed below:



Entry

- Teams will be required to meet on the Oval next to the Pick-up/Drop-off point and complete their warm-up using this space.
- Teams will be permitted to enter the playing facility 10 minutes before the start time of their fixture and once all participants from the previous fixture have exited.
- Teams are required to enter via the gate on the east side of the facility closest to the tennis courts.
- Teams are required the enter the facility as a group and head directly to the field they are playing on.
- All Staff and students must use hand sanitizer as they enter the facility.
- All Staff will be required to register using the QR Code at the entry gate.

During

- · Match balls will be provided by Ascham and should be the only balls used for matches.
- Teams are required to stay in one location on the side of the field and separated from opposition teams
- · Dug outs are not permitted to be used by anyone
- · Spitting is not permitted at any time

Exit

- At the end of the match teams are required to clean the goal posts of the goal they were defending at the end of the match using the wipes provided.
- Referees will be required to clean the ball at the end of each match.
- Teams are required to collect their possessions and leave the facility as quickly as possible.
- · All Staff and students must use hand sanitizer as they exit the facility.
- Teams are to exit via the gate on the west side of the facility closest to the basketball courts.
