

IGSSA Term 4 COVID-19 Safety Measures

General Rules

- All staff, officials, spectators and students who display any cold or flu symptoms or are generally unwell are to remain at home and not attend the venue.
- Participating schools are expected to ensure that all staff members are provided with the IGSSA safety plan
- Participating schools are expected to ensure that all staff members are provided with information and training on COVID-19, including when to get tested, physical distancing, cleaning and how to manage a sick student.
- Parent spectators are permitted at IGSSA venues unless otherwise specified (refer to the IGSSA website). People should maintain physical distance of at least 1.5 metres, practice good hand hygiene and engage in routine cleaning and disinfection of surfaces. Four (4) square metres of space per person must be implemented in indoor water polo venues.
- All individuals (including staff, players, officials and spectators) are strictly excluded if they
 have visited Victoria or a border town location on the NSW-Victorian border (e.g. AlburyWodonga, Moama-Echuca) in the 14 days prior to the event.
- All individuals (including staff, players, officials and spectators) are strictly excluded if they
 have attended any of the reported case locations listed on the NSW Health website
 - (https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/latest-news-and-updates#latest-covid-19-case-locations-in-nsw) in the 14 days prior to the event.
- Schools are asked to encourage participants to bring their own water bottle, snacks and sweat towels. Please avoid shared food and drinks.
- All staff, officials, spectators and students are encouraged to download the COVIDSafe app.
- Staff, officials, spectators and students are encouraged to limit the use of communal facilities where possible and not enter the facilities in groups.
- All individuals (including staff, players, officials and spectators) are required to follow all
 instructions provided by IGSSA staff and venue conveners.

Entry & Exit

 Teams will ONLY be permitted to enter the playing facility 15 minutes before the start time of their fixture. For water polo, venues should have a designated holding bay where teams must wait until both teams have left the pool.

- Students should arrive prepared to play.
- Teams are required to enter the facility and head directly to the field / pool they are playing on.
- All individuals (including staff, players, officials and spectators) must use hand sanitiser as they
 enter the facility / fields.
- All individuals (including staff, officials and spectators) are required to register using the QR Code at the entry point. Players are not required to sign in.
- Players are required to follow "get in, play, get out procedures" and should therefore leave immediately following their match (showering at venues will be prohibited).
- Teams must exit the venue as soon as their match is completed.
